 Reference to Shipping Marks must be made. 'No Marks' 'As addressed' 'As per Consignee' are all acceptable. These must appear on either the Invoice or Packing List and accompany the application.

Number and kind of packages (1): description of goods  
 A full commercial description of the goods is required, however, if this is shown on any accompanying invoices a more general description is acceptable. Under the description of goods 'As per invoice number...dated...' must be stated. You must also include details of how the goods are packed and the type of packages. The use of 'STC' is acceptable. For Mexico & Chile, the Tariff code of the goods must appear after the description.

9. Gross weight (kg) or other measure (litres, cu. m., etc)

These conditions, and guidance on the completion of this form, are explained in Customs Notices 827, 828 and 832.

**Penalties for furnishing untrue information**

Accordingly, any person who does so in support of an application for the issue of a movement certificate, or in the course of any subsequent verification, may be liable to penalties.
