Export Documentation Focus

Description of Goods.

When applying for a Certificate of Origin, EUR1 or ATR it is not necessary to list all the items in the shipment.

To save you time and space, a general description of the goods is acceptable providing you follow the guidance below -

- do not use brand names to describe the goods i.e 'Bisto' should be 'granulated gravy granules'
- include reference to both the invoice number and invoice date
