Export Documentation Focus

Certificates of Free Sale

The goods you are exporting and where to will determine whether you require a Certificate of Free Sale (CFS).

You may need to have the CFS certified by us and we advise that you submit the original in case legalisation is required. You should also check with your customers that the CFS is acceptable to the authorities in the destination country.
